Description:

After successful completion of either the Nursing Assistant Skills I (NAA100) or Medicaid Nurse Aide (MNA100) course you will be scheduled to take the State Competency Evaluation. You will then be placed on the Kentucky Nurse Aide Registry, and you will be able to work in a variety of health care settings including hospitals, medical offices, home health care, Hospice, private duty settings, assisted-living homes, long term care and mental health facilities.

Description:

This course provides training for nurses who are occupationally competent, but who have no formal training in educational methodology. Lecture.

Pre-requisites: Persons enrolling for this course must meet other requirements outlined by Medicaid Services.
