



Diploma programs as well as certificate options are available at BCTC in many technical programs. A diploma is designed to prepare students for employment in a specific technical field in three to four semesters. A certificate can be earned in as little as one semester and is primarily offered in technical programs.

Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.)
This degree is awarded to students who complete our health or technical programs of study.

Associate in Science (A.S.)
This degree covers majors in science-related disciplines such as Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics and Medicine.

Associate in Arts (A.A.)
This degree covers majors in liberal arts disciplines including English, Education, History, Law and Psychology.

BCTC offers two-year Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.), and Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degrees. These two-year degrees can be used to open up new career options or to complete the first half of a bachelor's degree.
