





The *Lexington Herald-Leader* archives contain the full text of virtually every article published since 1983. Articles are added to the database usually within 48 hours of publication.

The *Courier Journal* archives contain the full text of virtually every article published since 1999. Articles are added to the database usually within 48 hours of publication.

<p>1) From the BCTC LRC homepage www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/lrc, select Find an Article under the <i>Quick Links</i> section at the center of the page.</p>	<p>2) The Lexington Herald Leader and Louisville Courier Journal links are located under the Newspapers category on the right side of the page.</p>
	<p>3) Enter the words or phrases that should be included in the articles you're looking for. Separate each word or phrase with spaces. <i>Ex. Wildcats basketball NCAA</i> (You do not need to type AND between your search terms)</p>
	<p>4) Choose: Newest first (this will retrieve the most recent articles) OR Best matches first (this will retrieve the most relevant articles first)</p>

	<p>You can also Browse the news for a specific day:</p> <p>--Under the Search area is the Browse an Issue area</p> <p>You can choose a recent issue (last five days).</p> <p>You can also look at a particular date (like August 3, 2001)</p> <p>--Then hit Enter or click the Browse button.</p>
