


Academic Search Premier

Academic Search Premier, designed specifically for academic institutions, is a scholarly, multi-disciplinary full text database containing full text for nearly 4,600 scholarly publications, including more than 3,500 peer-reviewed publications.

• Using the Cite feature, Academic Search Premier will display several citation styles (APA, MLA, etc.) for you to choose from. Cut and paste this into your document, but <u>check it for accuracy</u>, because frequently the citation is slightly wrong (but a good start).

HINT: Be sure to check with your instructor about the accuracy of your citation before handing in your paper.
