Transfer FAQs

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at Brsecia University?

Only those transferable credits will be averaged into the new GPA at Brescia.

Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred? Maximum of 67 credit hours. However, Brescia University does offer a block transfer agreement to all AA or AS graduates of KCTCS institutions. Details can be found on our website at www.brescia.edu.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree?

A minimum of 42 credit hours must be earned at Brescia University. Within the 42 credit hours, the student must have completed the final one-third of the major requirements and the final thirty credit hours toward the degree at Brescia.

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?

Yes. A student must complete three hours of a modern language.

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships? Yes, Brescia University offers transfer scholarships to students who have a GPA greater than a 3.0.

How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid?

All students are considered for institutional scholarships and financial aid at the point of acceptance. To apply for federal and state financial aid, students must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC? Will my academic bankruptcy be honored?

Classes on the official transcript will be evaluated for credit.
